Upward of 1 million patients fall in U.S. hospitals each year, and a quarter of falls result in injury. Each fall with injury costs hospitals an average of \$27,500 as a result of additional services that are often not reimbursed.

Organizations fully implementing the program achieve an average 58% reduction in all falls and 68% fewer falls with injury.

This translates to safer care, reduced harm events, and measurable improvements in quality metrics and operational efficiency which can yield cost savings. 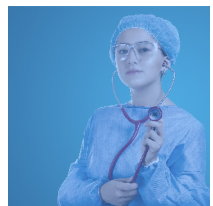
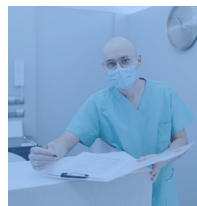

Program Success

Fewer Falls and Falls with Injury

- An 8 hospital system in the northeast reduced falls with injury by 59% in their first year using the program.
- A large, urban safety net hospital implemented the program in 2019 and maintained 15 consecutive months of fall rates below the NDNQI benchmark during COVID, despite peak patient volumes.



Cost Savings

- Program implementation at large, mid-Atlantic hospital system saved approximately \$860,000 by reducing their fall rate.
- A faith-based, not-for-profit health system in the midwest saves an estimated \$2.5 million annually through their use of the evidence-based program
